

- 1) What is an INFINITIVE in English? Give 2 examples.  
The most basic, non-conjugated form of a verb and almost always starts with “to”  
(ex) to kick, to run, to eat, to sleep
- 2) What is an INFINITIVE in Spanish? Give 2 examples.  
The most basic, non-conjugated form of a verb and ends with “-ar”, “-er”, “-ir”  
(ex) hablar, comer, escribir
- 3) What is a STEM in English? Give 2 examples.  
It is what’s left when you take off the word “to”  
(ex) kick, run, eat, sleep
- 4) What is a STEM in Spanish? Give 2 examples.  
It is what’s left when you take off the last 2 letters of the infinitive (“-ar”, “-er”, “-ir”)  
(ex) habl, com, escrib

English Pronouns	Spanish Pronouns	-AR (endings)
I	yo	-o
you	tú	-as
he, she	él, ella, Ud	-a
we	nosotros(as)	-amos
y'all	vosotros(as)	-áis
they	ellos, ellas, Uds	-an

**hablar** = to speak    **trabajar** = to work    **charlar** = to chat

- 1) She speaks Spanish a lot.  
Ella habla mucho.
- 2) They (feminine) work a lot.  
Ellas trabajan mucho.
- 3) You (singular familiar) chat a lot.  
(Tú) charlas mucho.
- 4) Y'all chat a lot. – (Vosotros) charláis mucho.
